1979 – 1992: Attended a Waldorf School in Ueberlingen (Germany), successfully

completing "Abitur" (the German equivalent of Matric or the British A-Levels) in

July 1992.

handicapped adults as part of a practical.

**Jun. – Dec. 1988:** First visit to South Africa as an exchange student for six months.

children), running Aids awareness workshops, facilitating a community development project, co-founding and running a bridging programme for street children and conducting person-centred individual and group therapy sessions with mentally challenged, sexually and physically abused, disabled and

otherwise underprivileged children.
